Dr. Christiaan Barnard performed the first human heart transplant in South Africa in December of 1967. Apart from being a famous medical researcher and heart surgeon, Chris was a highly controversial figure outside the operating theatre. His career was intertwined with politics where he acted on both behalf of the government and against it.

He achieved notoriety, however, when it came to his relationships with women. His three marriages paled in significance when compared with his encounters with beautiful women from all over the world.

In this talk Nick will share his growth and success from childhood until his death in 2001, interwoven with his experiences with the many females who succumbed to his handsome looks, boyish charm and of course, fame.

Nick French, our speaker was born in Zimbabwe, studied material science and business management and worked in various positions in South Africa, eventually working for an energy and petrochemicals company. In 1995, he was transferred to Singapore and held a number of positions in general management, marketing, and risk management. After 20 years, he launched his own business specialising in the field of **Cultural Intelligence** - developing meaningful and profitable business relationships between different cultures around the globe.

He is the Chairman of the Probus Association of the Western Cape and the president of The Probus Council of South Africa and also a Distinguished Toastmaster.
