Darryl Anderson is our speaker this coming Friday. He is the Executive director of Mercy Ships Canada, a registered charity based out of Victoria, British Columbia.

Mercy Ships is a faith-based international development organization and registered charity in Canada whose mission is to bring accessible healthcare services to people who cannot afford them. They do this with volunteers who offer surgical, eye and dental care free of charge. They also provide training programs to help local healthcare workers provide better care to their communities for sustainable change.

Mercy Ships currently have two world-class hospital ships. More than 1,600 volunteers bring necessary medical care, surgeries and capacity-building to Africa. Many skilled volunteers are needed to crew the ships, including electricians, plumbers, deck officers, marine engineers, teachers, surgeons, nurses, galley staff, IT support, and more.

In June 2020, Mercy Ships Canada was named one of Circle Act's Absolute Top 99.5% Charities in Canada who bring high-impact positive change.
